

Final results of investigation of Kathy Wilson murder 8/13/10

After going to the Warren Prothonotary again this Tuesday and getting what seems to be the last documents available there, of police reports, etc., it appears more disturbing information has been ignored.

Shelly Anderson had been planning to leave for California, with Buckley and Brown, some time before the Wilson disappearance. It didn't say how long before; but since she said it would have been with Brown AND Buckley, they were working together on that plan.

Her relationship interest was in Brown; she was 19(?) Brown had told her he was 20; though he was really 17.

She had sex with Buckley, but he became jealous and flattened her car tires, broke her antenna; she was upset with Buckley and said he was crazy.

Shelly was to have gone between for getting drugs for Brown; she was his connection, or at least the gofer.

The belief that Brown had been paid in advance for loyalty to bikers by receiving a new Harley 883, puts him in connection with bikers and drugs; Shelly would have also been in that same group. It is very possible she knew Earl Barnes and other bikers.

Bikers with drugs were probably mingled with the truck thieves; Buckley was about to testify against them; the retaliation against Buckley would be severe;

The same drug guys would have known Shelly; and may have known that Buckley harmed her car, etc;

So- the bikers/truck thieves would have the extra incentive of setting up Buckley; where Shelly knew he was being set up; Shelly also was tight with Brown; Brown was the main guy to set Buckley up for the murder of Wilson; Shelly Anderson was probably just as involved in that scheme as Brown.

Shelly said she had quit her job before Wilson disappeared, given a week's notice; just in time to be able to drive Buckley around; help with the abduction; maybe soothe Kathy when she was beaten; may have assisted in getting Kathy to Barnes' trailer and keeping her quiet.

Brown's original testimonies included Shelly in them; driving the minivan, wiping fingerprints, etc; it is very possible she WAS involved.

She was never incarcerated; never a suspect; as her involvement would have indicated murder for hire; not rape and theft.

So;

This theory does not jive with the theory of Wilson being at the Chautauqua Mall, seen by 5 people; that theory works based on the communications guy Strickland meeting her at the Mall, hitting her in anger and taking her to Barnes' property.

It does not gel with a planned event; conspiracy against Buckley from before the event; it works on the notion of having to kill Wilson after hitting her, deciding it was the best option.

The new facts give cause to believe Buckley was set up well BEFORE the disappearance; malice against Buckley as retribution for testimony against his friends; blended with murder of Wilson as killing two birds with one stone.

There may be a blending of these theories; but they at this time seem quite distant and exclusive of each other.
